The CPCA is proud to announce that we're expanding our Association to invite all "Peace Officers and Auxiliary Members" to join us in our curling fraternity. Any person who is designated a Peace Officer or Auxiliary Officer with at least two years of service within any Provincial or Territorial Association in which they reside. This may include but is not restricted to Canadian Border Services Agency (CBSA), Customs Officers, Correctional Officers, and, Conservation and Fisheries Officers. These are to be determined by the National Executive on a case by case submission. Are members in good standing within the Provincial or Territorial Association in which they reside. These persons must play on a team with a minimum of two regular member Police Officers that are in good standing with their Provincial or Territorial Association. 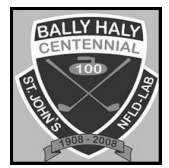
